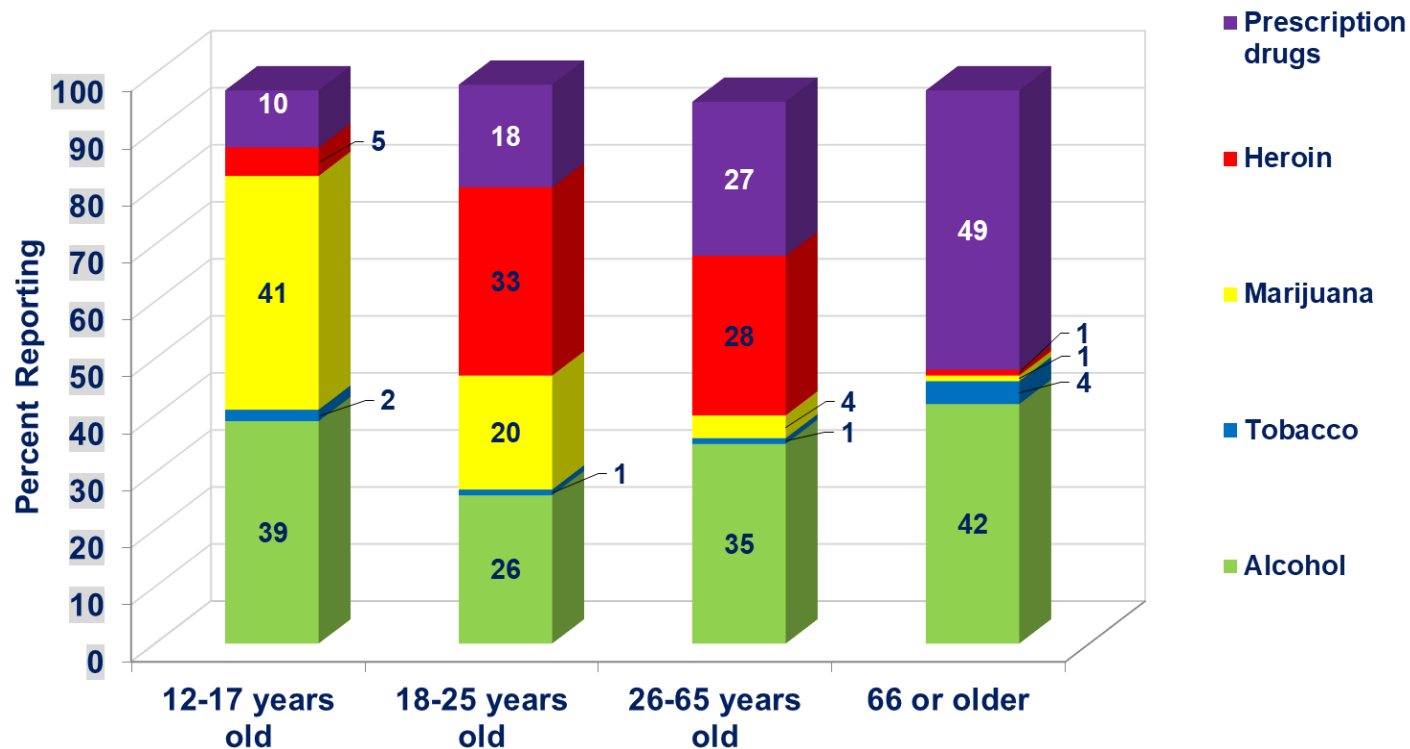


## Problem Substances of Greatest Concern According to Key Informants By Age Group: Connecticut Community Readiness Survey (CRS), 2016



**Title:** Problem Substances of Greatest Concern According to Key Informants By Age Group: Connecticut Community Readiness Survey (CRS), 2016

**Source of Data:** 2016 Connecticut Community Readiness Survey (CRS)

**Description:** These data show the perception of Problem Substances for each age group by key informants who took the 2016 CRS. Heroin was perceived as a substance of great concern for young adults (age groups 18-25). For older adults (26-65 years old) Alcohol followed by Heroin and Prescription Drugs were the most perceived concerns. While for adolescents, Marijuana followed by Alcohol were the most problem substances as perceived by key informants. For older population, 66 or older, Alcohol as well as Prescription Drugs were the top problematic substances.
